- Political and sectorial discrimination in labour market
- Aggressively violent counter-campaign by yellow-union, BLUFF (backed by the ruling powers)

Migrant workers are 77% of the Bahraini workforce

They mostly work in construction and domestic services

Nepal, one of the poorest countries in the world, supplies most of the migrant labour to Bahrain

They suffer exploitation, discrimination, low salaries and risk of life and limb and deportation

However, the union movement is fighting back!

The ITUC, Global Unions, and the Nepalese and Bahraini unions are launching a worker organising campaign to defend the rights of domestic workers!
