Labour Code Shortcomings

- Unreasonable restrictions on the right to strike,
- Poor regulation of working hours, maternity protection and compensation for overtime and night work
- Employment contract provisions heavily biased towards the employer
- Free reign of employers to conduct mass dismissals without prior consultation with unions
- Severe lack of labour law enforcement with no labour inspections



The GTUC continues to organise workers and supports its affiliates to fight for fair collective bargaining.

It will also work to change and amend the Labour Code so that it reflects the true needs of Georgian workers.
